Addendum 2 – Revised.

In the first 15 overs of first innings of both sides, **10 overs will be bowled by Pace bowlers only.**

The above restriction will not apply only if –

The Umpires have decided that light is unsafe for pace bowlers to bowl and the Fielding side captain agrees to bowl with spinners.

Please note -

This restriction is not applicable for the second innings of both teams in the match. The above regulation will apply for the entire tournaments, i.e. league to finals.

For the sake of conformity -

- The bowling restriction of maximum 20 overs per bowler will still apply.
- This restriction will apply only for the league phase of the tournament.
- It shall not be applicable for the Super League and knockout matches.
