



Highlighted Playing Conditions

Women's UNDER 15 ONE DAY TOURNAMENT 2025-26

Except as varied hereunder, MCA senior women's One-day limited over PC (2025-26) shall apply

1. The Matches will be played in White clothing.
2. The matches shall be played with one red ball per innings

3. Hours of play:

09.30 am	–	11.50 am	1 st Innings
11.50 am	–	12.30pm	Lunch Break
12.30 pm	–	2.50 pm	2 nd Innings

The match shall be of duration of 35 overs per side unless the team gets all-out earlier.

No bowler shall bowl more than 7 overs in an innings.

Two drinks breaks shall be taken in each innings each 45 minutes apart.

If an innings ends 30 minutes or more before the scheduled time for Lunch, a 10 minutes innings break will be taken and second innings will be started.

Lunch will be taken at the scheduled time in such cases.

Where the innings of the side batting first is delayed or interrupted, the length of the interval will be reduced as follows:

The minimum interval shall be of 30 Minutes

The prescribed interval timing above may be reduced further by the MCA Match Referee/ Match Umpires taking into account the intention of not having a prolonged interval after a lengthy interruption close to the conclusion of the innings of the team batting first. However, the minimum interval shall not be less than ten minutes.

Template forms will be used to recalculate the match details in case of Delay or interruption due to Rain/ Bad weather or other unavoidable circumstances.



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There is no provision of any extension or extra time.

In-field penalty for slow over rate shall not apply.

4. **Duration of Power-Play overs (In an uninterrupted game):**

There shall be no separate power-play overs. Field restrictions for all 35 overs shall be the same as mentioned below:

At the instant of delivery there shall be a minimum of 5 fielders inside the 23 mtr (25.15 yards) circle.

5. **Penalty Time**

The maximum penalty time for a fielder going off the field is to be capped at 45 minutes.

6. **Over Rates**

The over rate to be achieved in the U-15 women's match is 15 overs per hour.

7. **The Pitch and Boundaries**

The pitch dimensions shall be of 66ft X 10ft. There shall be no reduction in the measurements of the pitch to be used.

The boundary of the field of play shall be marked exactly at a distance of 50.29 metres (55 yards) measured from the centre of the pitch to be used.

8. **Prematurely Terminated Matches - Calculation of the Target Score**

a. **Interrupted Matches - Calculation of the Target Score**

If, due to suspension of play after the start of the match, the number of overs in the innings of either team has to be revised to a lesser number than originally allotted (minimum of 10 overs), then a revised target score (to win) should be set for the number of overs which the team batting second will have the opportunity of facing.

This revised target is to be calculated using the VJD method. The target set will always be a whole number and one run less will constitute a Tie.



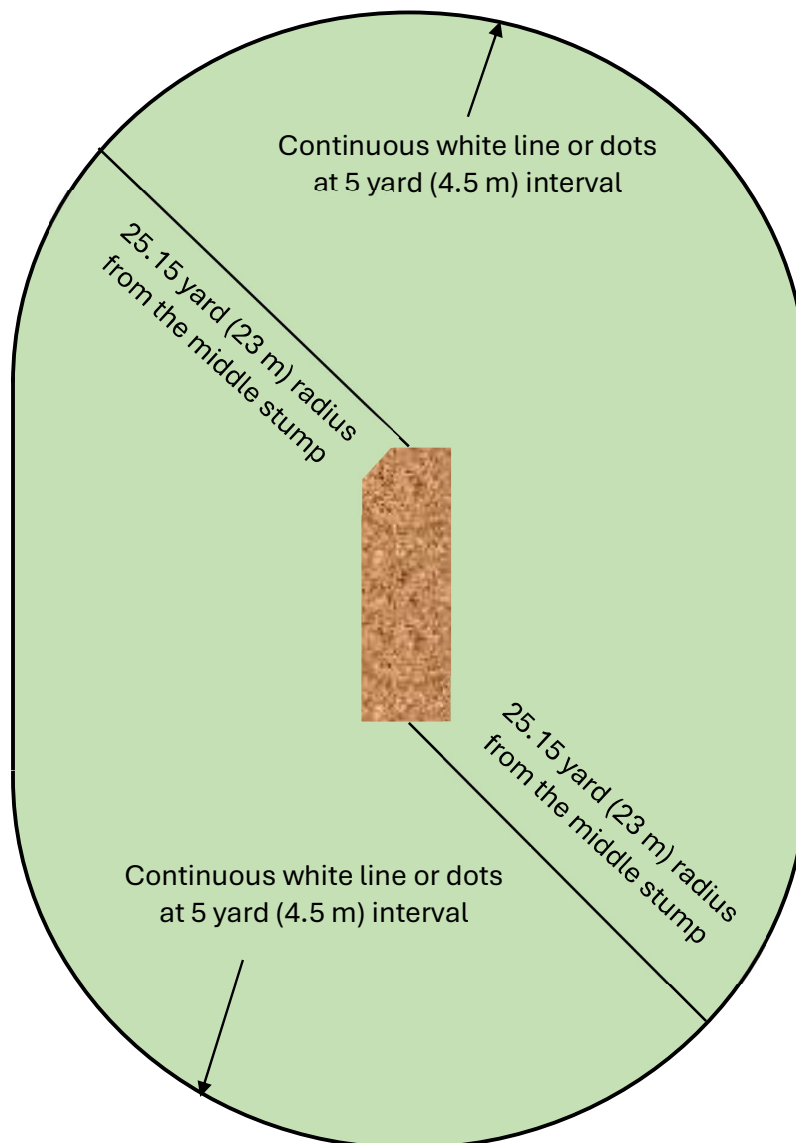
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b. Prematurely Terminated Matches

If the innings of the side batting second is suspended (with at least 10 overs bowled) and it is not possible for the match to be resumed, the match will be decided by comparison with the VJD 'Par Score' determined at the instant of the suspension by the VJD method. If the score is equal to the par score, the match is a Tie. Otherwise the result is a victory, or defeat, by the margin of runs by which the score exceeds, or falls short of, the Par Score.
